#### My Dear People,

It is important for us all to watch the news, however distressing it may be. I often joke, 'We are supposed to live the Good News but everyday we hear the bad!' For many years I have watched the news from 'Al Jazeera'. Like every news outlet it has its own particular bias, however, I watch it as it always has news of the Middle East, where I was born and raised. It also has a lot of world news not covered by our own channels. In the last month the images from Gaza have been the most cruel and depressing scenes I have ever seen. About 20,000 civilians have been killed, many more injured and many more psychologically damaged for the rest of their lives. All of this only fuels more hatred instead of finding a solution. Original Sin means that there will always be violence and revenge but there is a way out: The Gospel of Jesus Christ. His teaching shows us the way to live in peace. As we pray for a cessation of war we also pray that some good might come out of this horrendous pain and suffering.

We Catholic Christians do not know how Blessed we are to have the message of the Gospel to show us the 'better way'. In Advent we do three things: firstly, we prepare to celebrate the First Advent at Christmas, 2023 year ago. Secondly, we are reminded by the liturgy that we are waiting for His 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming, the end of the world. Thirdly, the Saints remind us that Advent is always 'now' and we invite the Holy Spirit into our hearts and minds to bequeath His unique wisdom. On Saturday night we have our Carols at St. Augustine's at 5.00pm and Fr. Daniel from Broadstairs will come for the 5.30 Mass at St. Ethelbert's with Confessions before and after.

May Our Blessed Lady obtain for us the Grace of a Happy Advent.
