#### My Dear People,

The second reading in the Ordinary Form of the Mass for this week is from St Paul's first letter to the Corinthians. Corinth was the largest city in Greece at the time with around 100,000 inhabitants, two thirds of whom were slaves. It was a trading city and its population was very cosmopolitan. It was also notorious for its low-level of morality. Life "Corinthian-style" was synonymous with sexual license. The main cult in the city was devoted to Aphrodite and the temple to her was staffed by "priestesses" who practiced what was euphemistically called "sacred prostitution". St Paul was therefore writing in a society which had lost all sense of sexual sin. And some Christians in Corinth were no different claiming that that sexual indulgence was an exercise of their new-found freedom in the Gospel.

Today there are some Catholics, even in the Vatican as Fr Christopher pointed out last week in the newsletter, who take this liberal line arguing in favour of "blessing" second "marriages" and homosexual activity. In our second reading, St Paul rejects the heresy of liberalism in respect of sexual morality – he uses the word *porneia* for it which is where we get "pornography" from - and urges the Christians of Corinth to live chastely because "your body... is the temple of the Holy Spirit".
