### My Dear People,

In todays' Gospel we see Our Blessed Lord confronting the Evil One. So often we can feel overwhelmed by the forces of evil, hatred and injustice in our world. How much do we need a Saviour! At the heart of the proclamation of Jesus is the call for each of us to repent. That clears the path for us to properly stand up against the forces of evil in our own personal life and beyond. When we look at a situation like Gaza with so many being killed every day (26,000; a third of them children) we yearn for some way out of this human quagmire. It seems there is no solution to this conflict and this scenario in smaller ways happens at some point, in every one of our lives. We get involved in a mess, often make it worse and then struggle to extricate ourselves from this misery. All the more reason that we need to live the life of grace, making the most of Confession, Holy Communion, the Rosary and the Mass. Without the Grace of God, we are consigned to staying in our predicament. Thanks be to God for our Saviour and His Gospel of peace!

On 10<sup>th</sup> February, Bishop Paul Hendricks (now the Assistant Bishop for Kent) is coming to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to 30 young people and a few adults. Please pray for them to use this gift of grace all the days of their lives. On the very same day Sister Mildred Mary, at Minster, will be Solemnly Professed. (I cannot believe it is 5 years since I attended her Simple Profession). Religious Profession is a radical expression of living our Baptism and Confirmation. In addition to the ordained ministry which serve the Church sacramentally we have the religious life which is essentially a presence of witness and service. In the old days we had a dozen convents in Thanet serving the Church in educational and healing ministry and now there are only two left, one is our Monastery of the ten Sisters at Minster!

Let us pray for all of these and may we really utilise the amazing Grace of God! We ask Our Lady's prayers.
