My Dear People,

Congratulations to all of you who were Confirmed yesterday! Many thanks to Bishop Paul for coming and for the hard work done by Mrs Patricia Smalley and Mrs Julie Rydz. Thanks also to the lovely efforts of the choir and the altar servers. May each of these candidates do something beautiful with their lives for God and in service of our poor old world! We also congratulate Sister Mildred Mary who was Solemnly Professed yesterday at Minster.

This coming Ash Wednesday is the beginning of LENT. Now is the time to think about the areas we will focus on. The Liturgy of the Day maps out three ways forward: PRAYER, FASTING, ALMSGIVING. Therefore, during Lent we should think about some sort of EXTRA prayer, fasting and almsgiving. We should not be overly ambitious and we should keep it relatively simple. Almsgiving is not just the giving of money but also our time. I think a good way to observe Lent is make the most of the weekday Masses. We are amazingly blessed to have FOUR Masses every day in our parish. St. Ethelbert's 9.30am, St. Augustine's 12.00noon, Minster Priory 9.00am and Divine Retreat 5.30pm. Please make the most of these wonderful occasions of Grace!

Something else that happens in our parish on a regular basis is Eucharistic Adoration. At St. Ethelbert's every weekday morning this happens at 8.30am and at St. Augustine's every Tuesday from 12.30 - 3.00pm. Our Nuns and The Divine Retreat Centre also have Adoration and this is a most powerful prayer.

We are so blessed, indeed spoilt with plentiful food etc. that we often have lost the ability to say 'no' to ourselves. It is important to teach the children to observe Lent and when they return from Half Term I will suggest they do a 'plus and a minus'. In other words, doing something extra and giving something up. The word 'Lent' is Anglo Saxon referring to the lengthening of days, in other words Spring. We all perceive Spring as something positive. We pray that we can regard Lent with the same positivity and ask Our Lady's Intercession.
