## My Dear People,

This past Wednesday we inaugurated the 40 days of Lent by receiving the Blessed Ash. The Gospel tells us how (and how not) to pray, fast and give alms. These three areas should be components for all of us in Lent. As I said last week in the notices we are amazingly blessed as a parish to have **four regular weekday Masses (9.00am** Minster, **9.30am** St. Ethelbert's, **12.00noon** St. Augustine's, **5.30pm** Divine Retreat). The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is not just a religious service. It is our entering into the eternal sacrifice of Our Blessed Lord Jesus to Our Father in the light and grace of the Holy Spirit. It is our encounter with the living God. It is a window into the life of grace. Even if we do not go to Holy Communion, St. Thomas teaches us, we can still receive the grace from making a Spiritual Communion. Holy Mass includes the Holy Word of God, prayers for the living and the dead, offering of our joys and sorrows and the real presence of Our Blessed Lord on the altar. St. John Vianney the Holy Curé of Ars said, 'If we only knew what the Mass was we would die of love.' Let us therefore make the most of these weekday Masses, so poorly attended and support them at least some of the days of the week.

We pray to Our Blessed Lady that she may obtain for each of us a deeper appreciation of the Holy Mass!
