Dear Parishioners

As you many of you know, I have recently had an operation for a retinal detachment. It seems to have gone well though I still have a grey bubble in the eye which distorts the sight making things I see out of that eye bounce around! However, the bubble is gradually disappearing leaving decent vision above it. Deo gratias! And thanks to you for those prayers and Masses for my "well-being".

That's a term we all know these days – it's even found in the modern translation of the Canon of the Mass. In the Commemoration of the Living, the priest offers the Mass "in hope of health and well-being" for the people whom he names either aloud or silently.

Masses for this intention are, I think, a reminder to us that God cares, not only about the state of our souls, but the health of our bodies too. From the beginning it was God's purpose that we should be both souls *and* bodies. We know that "the image of God is chiefly in my soul" (Penny Catechism Question 4) since our souls are spiritual and God is pure spirit, but that doesn't mean that the human body is without dignity. A distinguished Dominican theologian explains: "the image of God is in our bodies in a secondary way precisely because it is a human body and not a bestial one." And the same writer concludes by pointing out that whereas prayer and confession are the spiritual disciplines of Lent for cleansing our souls, Holy Mother Church does not neglect the health of our bodies in this season. She has given us the practice of fasting, the aim of which is to help us gain mastery of our concupiscenses or disordered desires for pleasure, in order to become well beings in both body and soul.
