My Dear People,

In the Gospel today and the prophecy we are confronted with the problem of Leprosy. Leprosy is a biblical sign of sin from which we all suffer. Our Blessed Lord calls us to repent and we have to do that every day. In the Old Testament, once the Leprosy was healed, they had to show themselves to a priest so as to be declared clean. Today after repentance we need to go to Confession for grave sins to be declared clean before Holy Communion. Whether we are in grave sin or not it is a very good practice to go to Confession regularly. It is like weeding a garden, it needs continual care. If we do not keep control of these weeds, the Leprosy of sin can overwhelm us and even lead to our destruction. That is why Our Blessed Lord is constantly warning us to repent and turn away from the ugly infectious Leprosy of sin. The good news is that there is a way out of this quagmire and that is the Grace of God which is the Holy Spirit of Love.

We congratulate our group of Confirmation Candidates who will receive the Sacrament from Bishop Paul Hendricks who is the Auxiliary to Our Archbishop and is especially responsible for the Parishes of Kent. We pray that each of the newly Confirmed will do something beautiful for God with their lives. We also congratulate Sr. Mildred Mary, at Minster, as she is making her Solemn Profession. She will renew her vows of poverty, chastity and obedience having received the ring and the black veil at her 1st Profession, five years ago. These are symbols of the nuptial quality of the whole Church. Our Blessed Lord is the bridegroom of our souls and Religious women (Nuns) demonstrate this explicitly by their habit and by their radical lives of witness.
