Dear Parishioners,

Today is 'Good Shepherd Sunday' when traditionally we pray for Vocations to the priesthood. Shepherding is something we are all called to do, especially parents but priests must shepherd in a spiritual way, nourishing souls with the Bread of Life and the Word of God. We desperately need more priests as the western world suffers from a demographic implosion. In other words, we do not have enough births so we have to import workers including priests! Our Archdiocese of Southwark (which comprises of all of London south of the river and the whole of Kent) now has about 45% of its priests from Africa! Ramsgate has only produced 2 priestly vocations in the last generation. One is Canon William Hudson of the Institute of Christ the King. He went to St. Augustine's School and is now Headmaster of a school in Belgium. The other is Fr. Krzyszof Senetra, originally Polish, who worked at The San Clu Hotel. With the help of Vincent and Roz Lennon he entered the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter and is now in Canada. We need to pray for more vocations every day as without priests there is no Mass and no Sacraments. The cultic ministry of priests is complemented by the prophetic ministry of the Religious. In our parish we are blessed to have 10 Religious Women, the Benedictine Nuns of Minster. Please pray everyday for your Priests and Religious and that there may be more vocations.
