Dear parishioners,

MARYS MEALS is a charity which has a vision that every child should receive one daily meal in their place of education and that all those who have more than they need, share with those who lack even the basic things. Working together with people who share their ideals such as catholic parishes in England, MARY'S MEALS believes that this vision can be achieved in this world where there is enough food for everyone.

Since 2022, about 2, 279.941 children have received MARY'S MEALS every school day. For twenty years MARY'S MEALS school feeding programmes have reached some of the most challenging regions in the world where poverty and hunger prevent children from attending from attending school. To support this good work, MARY'S MEALS has a scheme which collects the money which is often forgotten or lost by us in our homes when we come back from visits abroad and throw our unused foreign currency in a box or bowl, intending to use it again and never get around to it. Now we can put it to good use by picking up a MARYS MEALS foreign currency collection envelope from the back of the church and putting any unused foreign currency notes or coins in the box and then returning it to church. When the parish has collected 2kg or more of foreign currency, MARY'S MEALS will collect it from the church.

It costs £19.15 to feed a child for whole year. Our Lord Jesus Christ said 'For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink'. Let us bless the Lord by giving what we can to feed his little ones and support their education by giving them a meal.

I thank you all for your very warm welcome to me last weekend and for joyful celebration of mass for my induction and the great reception afterwards.
