We begin October, the month of the Holy Rosary, with Devotions this Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock, including a Parish Rosary, the Litany of Loreto, Benediction and some lovely Marian hymns. Bring your family and let us ask Our Lady's prayers for peace in our parish and the world. As bombs fall on the homes of families who have done nothing to harm anyone, let us ask Our Lady Queen of Peace and Queen of the family to pray for them. Could you imagine bombs raining down on Ramsgate because some foreign enemy had its agents scattered among us? There is no justice for poor ordinary people in Lebanon or The Holy Land and the aggressor hides behind the cowardice of great earthly powers who support it, regardless of how many people are killed, homes destroyed and lives completely devastated.

The Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem has also called for Monday 7th October 2024 to be a day of prayer, fasting, and penance for reconciliation and peace in the Holy Land amidst the ongoing violence and hatred. Pope Francis has also joined with the Patriarch in commending this day of prayer to all Christians. For more details, please pick up a copy of the Patriarch's message at the back of the church.

Pope St Pius X said 'The Rosary is the most beautiful and the most rich in graces of all prayers; it is the prayer that touches most the Heart of the Mother of God. and if you wish peace to reign in your homes, recite the family Rosary'. Let peace begin in our own hearts and homes as we pray for peace in the world. To this end, during October, our parish will also be saying the Rosary twice every day from Monday to Friday at 9.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. Our Lady of the Rosary, Queen of Peace and Queen of the Family, pray for us and those poor people in The Holy Land and Lebanon!
