By purchasing items from TBNG we support Christian families there, and if you buy the items now, you'll be thanking yourselves in December when you'll be thinking how clever you were to buy that gift on that hot Sunday in July in support of our brothers and sisters in Palestine. We also send our love and greetings to Mother Nickola and all our sisters at St Mildred's Priory, Minster on the Feast Day of their Holy Patron, St Mildred, this Sunday, with thanks for their hospitality to our First Holy Communion children last Sunday.
