Dear parishioners, firstly, a thank you from CAFOD for what they kindly call our 'generous' support this year and the latest donation of £45.00 which is 'transforming lives'. The message continues, 'Women like Ware no longer need to walk miles each day just to fetch water. Thanks to this project, Ware and her family now have safe, clean drinking water right at their doorstep. Ware herself said *'We were happy working together to achieve something by building this tank. We are optimistic that once it is full, it will support us'*. 'Thanks to your parish's generosity, families facing the injustices of poverty, conflict and climate change – people whose opportunities are limited through no fault of their own – are finding hope. With your kindness, they can gain new skills, unlock their God-given potential, and build a future where they can truly thrive'. Possibly some of you donated online: this is not counted in the parish total.

Speaking of injustice, this week we have seen Israel kill one hundred and four Palestinian civilians including about fifty children in revenge for the sniper attack and death of one Israeli soldier. Let us pray with all our hearts that this latest atrocity is not the return to the mass slaughter of ordinary Palestinians. What is a just response to the killing of a soldier? I refer you to the Catechism of the Catholic Church: *'the use of arms must not produce evils and disorders graver than the evil to be eliminated'* (2309). *'Every act of war directed to the indiscriminate destruction of whole cities or vast areas with their inhabitants is a crime against God and man which merits firm and unequivocal condemnation'* (2314) Let us pray that Israel might begin to act justly if provoked and that there will be a just settlement for all Muslims, Jews and Christians of God's Holy Land: living there together as neighbours and sharing the Holy Land in peace. Naïve? - but nothing is impossible for the love of God, even a lion might lay down with the lamb.

Please note the transfer of All Saints Day to Sunday, but this includes the Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> November. Likewise, All Souls is transferred to Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November. On **Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> November at 12.00 noon**. We welcome Canon Brian Coyle who will be saying the annual **Old Augustinian's Requiem mass** for the young men from St Augustine's school who were killed in the two world wars. We pray for their souls and give thanks to God for the sacrifice they made for us. You can see their names on the War Memorial there. I encourage you to attend and join us in our prayers for them. As always at this time, a plenary indulgence may be obtained applicable to the holy souls for all those who visit a cemetery between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> November. On Wednesday we also have the blessing of graves at Ramsgate Cemetery after 9.30 mass and next Sunday after the Sung Latin Requiem at 12.00 noon the Blessing of Graves at St Augustine's Cemetery.
