#### **THE PARISH LENT APPEAL.**

**'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart... and you shall love your neighbour as yourself'**  
(Mark12:29-31)

Let us give this Lent to help our neighbours grow enough food to eat.

This weekend we welcome a guest speaker from **CAFOD** (the Catholic Agency for Overseas Development) who will be telling us about this Lent's Family Fast Day Appeal. This Lent we remember people in Zimbabwe where there is too little rain and where God's creation is parched. We remember people in parts of Bangladesh and South Sudan, where there is too much rain, causing constant flooding. The result is the same for our neighbours – seeds fail to grow, plants die and families go hungry.

In Lent, we live out the Gospel to love our neighbours such as those in Zimbabwe, South Sudan and Bangladesh. By fasting and giving what we can save, we join in Christ's compassion and help another family put food on the table. Our donations can help families around the world grow food in difficult conditions – such as flood resistant floating gardens or using solar-powered water pumps in times of drought.
